### **LESSON PLAN**

### 1. Direct Instruction

Demonstrate **B** on the Slate Chalkboard or Gray Blocks. Say the words for each step.





Starting Corner

2. Guided Practice

Children finger trace step-by-step models on the page while saying the words.

Children trace B.

Children copy B.

#### 3. Check Letter

Monitor as children trace and copy letters for correct start and steps.

Read BED. Say **B** and make the /b/ sound. Encourage free coloring and drawing. Add person, toys, dresser, etc.


