

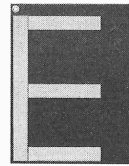

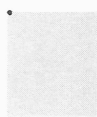

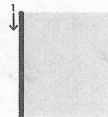

Say the words for each step.

**Lesson E:**

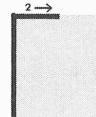
Start in the Starting Corner



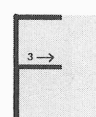
Big Line down



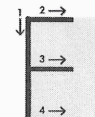
Frog Jump

**2. Guided Practice**

Children finger trace step-by-step models on the page while saying the words.  
Children trace E.  
Children copy E.

**3. Check Letter**

Monitor as children trace and copy letters for correct start and steps.

**READ, COLOR & DRAW**

Letter E makes two sounds. Stretch long /e/ at the beginning of eagle. Stretch short /e/ at the beginning of edge.

**ENRICHMENT**

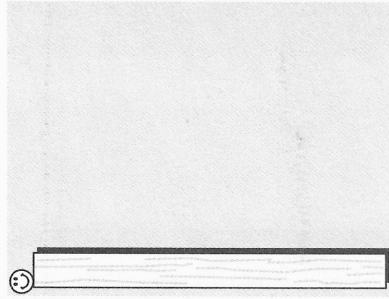
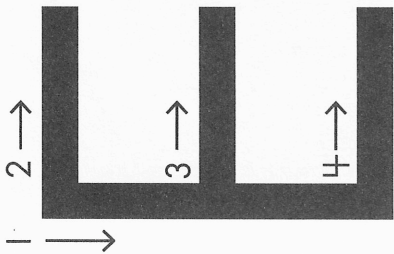
Have children identify capital E in an EXIT sign. Look for other signs/ words with capital E.

**SUPPORT/ELL**

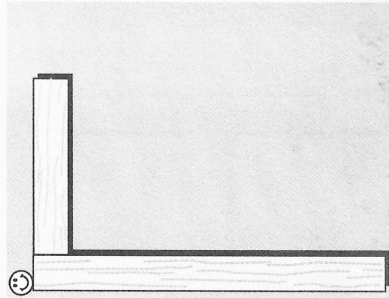
Have children practice top, middle, and bottom positions with Wood Pieces (p. 158).

**CROSS-CURRICULAR CONNECTIONS**

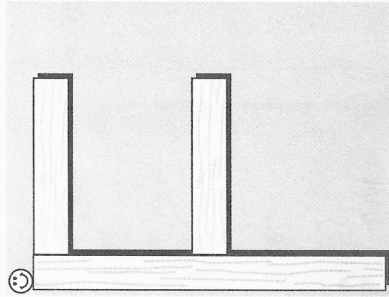
Social Studies: Bring in a picture book about eagles. Explain that the bald eagle is the national emblem of the USA.



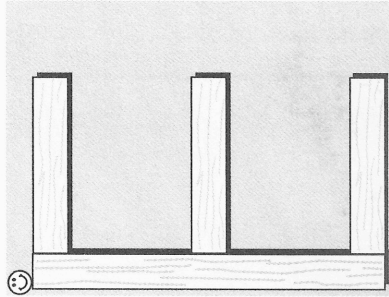
