



# **LESSON PLAN**

## 1. Direct Instruction

Demonstrate  ${\bf N}$  on the Slate Chalkboard or Gray Blocks. Say the words for each step.

Lesson N:



Start in the Starting Corner



Big Line down F



Frog Jump



Slide down



Big Line up

#### 2. Guided Practice

Children finger trace step-by-step models on the page while saying the words.

Children trace N.

Children copy N.

#### 3. Check Letter

Monitor as children trace and copy letters for correct start and steps.

# **READ, COLOR & DRAW**

Read NEST. Say  $\bf N$  and make the /n/ sound. Encourage free coloring and drawing. Add eggs, a bird etc.

#### **ENRICHMENT**

Call out the letter that makes the /n/ sound and have children write it on Gray Block Paper.
